



A BAC RESOLUTION DECLARING POST-QUALIFIED BIDDERS AND RECOMMENDING AWARD OF CONTRACTS FOR LOT 3-SPEECH LABORATORY AND LOT 4-AIRCONDITION UNIT OF THE PROCUREMENT OF CY 2022 IGI-FUNDED ICT AND LABORATORY EQUIPMENT IN COMPLIANCE TO REPUBLIC ACT NO. 9184 AND ITS 2016 REVISED IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS

WHEREAS, in compliance with the provisions of RA 9184 and its 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (R-IRR), the **Kalinga State University (KSU)** published the Invitation to Bid on the PhilGEPS Website: <https://notices.philgeps.gov.ph/> on **October 5-25, 2022** for the bidding of the following packaged lots for **Procurement of CY 2022 IGI-Funded ICT and Laboratory Equipment** with a total Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) amounting to **Seven Million, Eight Hundred Seventy Thousand Philippine Pesos (Php 7,870,000.00)** sourced from **Internally Generated Income (IGI) Fund for CY 2022** and posted the same at the KSU Website: <https://ksu.edu.ph/bid/procurement-various-laboratory-equipment-including-furniture-and-fixtures>, and conspicuous place at the premises of the University Campuses, continuously for **seven (7)** calendar days.

WHEREAS, in response to the said posting/advertisement, **nineteen (19) prospective bidders**, namely: Xitrix Computer Corporation, Elite Scientific and Diagnostic International Supplies Corporation, Need Ink Sales and Services, Automation Specialists and Power Exponents Incorporated, Philcom Enterprises, Tarilja Enterprises, Hytec Power Incorporated, Terabit Computer Systems Corporation, Juan Book Store, DCI International I.T. Solutions and Services Corporation, Pronet Systems Integrated Network Solution Incorporated ESCO Philippines Incorporated, J and G General Merchandise, State Alliance Enterprises Incorporated, GNF General Merchandise, Alejandra Enterprises, Allcard Incorporated, Govsmart Solutions Incorporated, and AVLS All Visual & Lights Systems Corporation, browsed/read the opportunity at the sites mentioned above and downloaded the bidding documents;

WHEREAS, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) and the Technical Working Groups (TWG) for IT and Laboratory related Supplies and Equipment conducted the **online Pre-bid Conference** via Google Meet link: meet.google.com/phj-uxwk-hyp with the prospective bidders and bidder's representatives on **October 13, 2022 @ 10:00 am** whereupon **Supplemental Bid/Bulletin (SBB) No. 01 dated October 18, 2022** were issued to amend the contents of bidding documents including the schedule of the bid opening;

WHEREAS, as per records of the BAC Secretariat, **only two (2) bidders purchased the bidding documents**, namely: AVLS All Visual & Lights Systems Corporation for Lot 3- Speech laboratory and Tarilja Enterprises for Lot 4- Aircondition Unit;

WHEREAS, AVLS All Visual & Lights Systems Corporation and Tarilja Enterprises, submitted their bid documents containing the technical and financial documents before the scheduled time;

WHEREAS, during the **Opening of Bids on October 25, 2022 @ 10:01 am**, the BAC, upon the recommendation of the TWG for IT related Supplies and Equipment, declared the bids of AVLS All Visual & Lights Systems Corporation and Tarilja Enterprises, as **"eligible"** and passed the technical evaluation of the bidding for Lot 3 and Lot 4, respectively;

WHEREAS, the TWG for IT-related supplies and equipment, upon the conduct of **Post-Qualification Evaluation** by the composite Post Qual Team on **November 10-11, 2022** recommended to the BAC to declare the bid of **AVLS All Visual and Lights Systems Corporation** and **Tarilja Enterprises** as **Single Calculated and Responsive Bid (SCRB)** for **Lot 3-Speech laboratory** and **Lot 4-Aircondition Unit of the Procurement of CY 2022 IGI-Funded ICT and Laboratory Equipment**, respectively;

WHEREFORE, RESOLVE AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the Bids and Awards Committee hereby recommends for approval by the University President the following:

- 1) to declare the bids of AVLS All Visual & Lights Systems Corporation for Lot 3- Speech Laboratory of the as Single Calculated and Responsive Bid (SCRB) and to recommend for approval by the University President an award of contract in the total amount of Two Million, Seven Hundred Ninety-Eight Thousand, Six Hundred Philippine Pesos (Php 2,798,600.00) pursuant to Section 36 of the revised IRR of RA No. 9184; and
- 2) to declare the bids of Tarilja Enterprises for Lot 4- Aircondition Unit as Single Calculated and Responsive Bid (SCRB) and to recommend for approval by the University President an award of contract amounting to Three Hundred Ninety-Seven Thousand, Nine Hundred Sixty Philippine Pesos (Php 397,960.00) pursuant to Section 36 of the revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

RESOLVED FINALLY to post this Resolution on the PhilGEPS and KSU Websites and conspicuous places at the University’s premises, including the BAC Bulletin Board, for transparency and information purposes.

By the power vested in me by the Kalinga State University Board of Regents, I hereby:


- APPROVE** the attached Resolution of the BAC based on the foregoing:
 - Section 34.4, 2016 R-IRR of RA 9184: **Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid (LCRB) or Highest Rated and Responsive Bid (HRRB).**
 - Section 36, 2016 R-IRR of RA 9184: **Single Calculated and Responsive Bid (SCRB) or Single Rated and Responsive Bid (SRRB).** *lot 3 & lot 4.*
 - Annex "D", 2016 R-IRR of RA 9184: **Appropriate adjustments in the delivery of contract schedule, or contract price, or both, with modification of contract.**

- DISAPPROVE** the attached Resolution of the BAC due to the following Reservation Clauses:
 - Section 41(a), RA 9184: **there is prima facie evidence of collusion.**
 - Section 41(b), RA 9184: **the BAC failed to follow bidding procedures.**
 - Section 41(c), RA 9184: **any justifiable and reasonable ground** where the award of contract will not redound to the benefit of the government.

- APPROVE BAC DECLARATION ON FAILURE OF BIDDING** based on the foregoing:
 - Section 35.1(a), 2016 R-IRR of RA 9184: **No bids received.** *lot 1 & 2*
 - Section 35.1(b), 2016 R-IRR of RA 9184: **Bids received, but no one was eligible.**
 - Section 35.1(c), 2016 R-IRR of RA 9184: **All bids failed to post qualify.**
 - Section 35.1(d), 2016 R-IRR of RA 9184: **Someone post qualified but refused without justifiable cause to accept the award.**

- SUBJECT FOR RE-BID** based on the following:
 - Section 35.2, 2016 R-IRR of RA 9184: **Task the BAC and TWG to conduct mandatory review and evaluation of the terms, conditions, specifications, and cost estimates in the bid documents.** *lot 1 & 2*
 - Section 35.3, 2016 R-IRR of RA 9184: **To task the BAC to conduct a re-bidding with re-advertisement and/or posting.**
 - Section 35.5, 2016 R-IRR of RA 9184: **To resort to negotiated procurement, specifically Two Failed Biddings (Sec. 53.1).**
