## A BAC RESOLUTION DECLARING A POST-QUALIFIED BIDDER AND RECOMMENDING FOR AWARD OF CONTRACT

BAC Resolution No. <u>075</u> Series of 2021

WHEREAS, in compliance with the provisions of RA 9184 and its 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (R-IRR), the Kalinga State University (KSU) published the Invitation to Bid in the PhilGEPS Website (https://notices.philgeps.gov.ph/) on January 14-21, 2021, for the bidding of Rehabilitation of the College of Education Building's Electrical Wirings with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) amounting to One Million, Four Hundred Fifty-Six Thousand, Three Hundred Eleven Philippine Pesos and Seventy-Two Centavos (Php 1,456,311.00) sourced from Internally Generated Income Fund for CY 2020 and posted the same at the KSU Website (https://ksu.edu.ph), and conspicuous place at the premises of the University Campuses continuously for seven (7) calendar days;

WHEREAS, in response to the said posting/advertisement, seven (7) prospective bidders, namely: Southlake Heavy Industries Inc., GNF General Merchandise, Tribu Design and Construction, Rose Ann Construction and General Merchandise, GCPK Construction and Supply, Adeb's Construction, and Gega Engineering and Construction browsed/read the opportunity at the sites mentioned above and downloaded the bidding documents;

WHEREAS, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) and the Technical Working Group for Infrastructure Projects (TWG-Infra) conducted the **Pre-bid Conference** simultaneously via Google Meet Link: meet.google.com/epo-hrmt-chu with the bidder's representatives on **January 22**, **2021 @ 1 pm** whereupon **Supplemental Bid/Bulletins (SBB) No. 01** dated January 18, 2021 and **SBB No. 02** dated January 28, 2021 were issued to amend the contents of bidding documents particularly on re-scheduling of the bid opening and PCAB license requirement;

WHEREAS four (4) bidders, namely: Rose Ann Construction and General Merchandise, GCPK Construction and Supply, Adeb's Construction, and Gega Engineering and Construction, have purchased the bidding documents on January 26, 2021, January 27, 2021 (2), and January 29, 2021, respectively;

WHEREAS, during the Receipt and Opening of Bids on February 8, 2021 @ 2:30 pm, said 4 bidders who purchased the bid documents, submitted their bid envelopes containing the technical and financial documents before 2:30 pm of February 8, 2021;

WHEREAS during the Opening of Bids, the BAC, upon the recommendation of the TWG-Infra, declared the bids of GCPK Construction and Supply and Gega Engineering and Construction as "ineligible" while the bids of Rose Ann Construction and General Merchandise and Adeb's Construction were both declared as "eligible" and passed the technical evaluation of the bidding;

WHEREAS the TWG recommended to the BAC, upon opening the Financial Bid Envelopes, to declare the bids of Rose Ann Construction and General Merchandise and Adeb's Construction as "complying", and declared further the offer of the former bidder in the amount of One Million, Two Hundred Ninety-Four Thousand, Six Hundred Eighty-Six Philippine Pesos and Eight Centavos (Php 1,294,686.08) as the lowest calculated bid and the bids as calculated are as follows:

WHEREAS, on February 9, 2021, the BAC Secretariat formally informed GCPK Construction and Supply and Gega Engineering and Construction on the ground of their "ineligibilities" and the former bidder did not file a motion for reconsideration after three (3) days of such receipt;

WHEREAS on February 11, 2021, Gega Engineering and Construction filed his motion for reconsideration, which the BAC denied on February 15, 2021.

WHEREAS, the TWG-Infra, upon the conduct of post-qualification evaluation by the Post Qual Team on February 17, 2021 recommended to the BAC to declare the bid of Rose Ann Construction and General Merchandise as the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid (LCRB);

WHEREFORE, RESOLVE AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Bids and Awards Committee, upon recommendation of the Technical Working Group for Infrastructure Projects, hereby recommends for approval by the University President to declare the bid of Rose Ann Construction and General Merchandise as Lowest Calculated Responsive Bid and to award the contract amounting to One Million, Two Hundred Ninety-Four Thousand, Six Hundred Eighty-Six Philippine Pesos and Eight Centavos (Php 1,294,686.08) for the Rehabilitation of the College of Education Building's Electrical Wirings.

**RESOLVED FINALLY** to post this Resolution at the PhilGEPS and KSU Websites and conspicuous place at the University's premises, including the BAC Bulletin Board, for transparency and information purposes.
