Based on the discussions during the Pre-bid Conference conducted last- January 11, 2023 for this Project, and upon confirmation by the Technical Working Group and the End-User Unit, below is the revision:																															
1. On ITB Clause No. 5.2 of the Bid Data Sheet, under Section III, page 14 of the Philippine Bidding Document, revision are as follows: For this purpose, contracts similar to the Project refer to contracts that have the same major categories of work, which shall be:	<p><i>Repair, Upgrading, Renovation and/or Improvement of Building, of equivalent size, and equivalent to at least fifty percent (50%) of the total ABC amounting to Php 975,875.25 or</i></p> <p><i>For bidders with no SLCC, a certification under oath invoking exception for the absence of SLCC <u>SLCC</u> under the Technical Documents and required by Sections 23.1(a)(v) and 23.4.2.4 of the 2016 IRR of RA 9184, shall be attached in the SLCC's Statement.</i></p>
