### SUPPLEMENTAL / BID BULLETIN (SBB) ADDENDUM NO. 01

This SBB Addendum No. 01 dated March 31, 2021, for the Project: Construction of KSU-Rizal Campus Goat Farm is issued to clarify, modify, or amend items in the Bidding Documents. Accordingly, this shall form an integral part of said Documents.

(Note: For this SBB and a better understanding of its contents, the following rules shall apply: (a) Double Strike out - denotes deletion, and (b) Underline - implies inclusion or new item/requirement).

#### **PARTICULARS**

#### **CLARIFICATION / AMENDMENT**

Based on the discussions during the Pre-bid Conference conducted on March 26, 2021 for this Project, and upon confirmation by the Technical Working Group and the End-User Unit, the following are the revisions:

- 1. On Paragraph No. 2 of the Invitation to Bid (IB) under Section I, page 6 of the Philippine Bidding Document, amendment on the Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC) requirement shall be the following:
  - 2. The Kalinga State University now invites bids for the above Procurement Project. Completion of the Works is required within One Hundred Seven (107) calendar days upon receipt of the Notice to Proceed. Bidders should have completed a contract similar to the Project. For those bidders with no SLCC yet, a certification under oath invoking exception for the absence of SLLC under the Technical Documents and required by Sections 23.1(a)(v) and 23.4.2.4 of the 2016 IRR of RA 9184 shall be attached after the SLCC Statement declares "none." The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly in Section II (Instructions to Bidders).
- 2. On ITB Clause No. 5.2 of the Bid Data Sheet, under Section III, page 14 of the Philippine Bidding Document, below is the revision:

5.2	For this purpose, contracts similar to the Project refer to contracts which have the same major categories of work, which shall be:	
	Construction of animal building or a barn One-Storey Building with at least more than 50% similarities with the major work component of the project (steelworks	
	welding), with a contract cost of not less than Php 1,366,850.00	

3. On No. 2 of the contract document requirements, ITB Clause No. 21 of the Bid Data Sheet, under Section III, page 14 of the Philippine Bidding Document, the revision is as follows:

4. On Item Letter I, number 4 of Project Requirements, Technical Documents of the Checklist for Eligibility and Technical Components under Section IX- Checklist of Technical and Financial Documents, page 36 of the Philippine Bidding Document, below is the revision:

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5. Concerning ITB Clause 16, which states that "Procuring Entity may request additional hard copies and/or electronic copies of the Bid," an additional clause shall be inserted after ITB Clause No. 15.1 of the Bid Data Sheet, under Section III, page 15 of the Philippine Bidding Document, as follows:

ITB Clause	
Each Bidder shall submit one (1) original and two (2) copies of the first components of its bid with the following conditions:	
	a) Any missing, incomplete, or patently insufficient document in the checklist is a ground for outright rejection (non-complying) of the bid.
16	b) For hassle-free and more uncomplicated bid evaluation, the Technical and Financial Envelopes are preferably soft bounded and with Ear-Tabbing for each Checklist. Ring bounded and "clipped with fastener" are discouraged.
	c) Each and every page of the Documents comprising the Financial Proposal shall be signed by the duly authorized representative/s of the Bidder. Failure to do so shall be a ground for the rejection of the bid.
