VI. PROVISIONS FOR STORAGE & MATERIAL HANDLING

- **6.1** The Contractor shall store his materials, equipment and tools in one place of the construction site during construction. The area shall be coordinated with the KSU Infrastructure Unit. It shall be kept neat and clean at all times. Any damage thereto or to the surrounding area arising from any accident, paint spills, etc. shall be repaired and/or restored to its original condition. 




