



**A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING ALTERNATIVE METHOD OF PROCUREMENT THROUGH NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT UNDER HIGHLY TECHNICAL CONSULTANTS AND RECOMMENDING FOR AWARD**

BAC Resolution No. 626, s. 2018  
**CONSULTING SERVICES**

**WHEREAS**, the Kalinga State University (KSU) seeks to attain economy and efficiency in all aspects of its procurement operations by resorting to the above-mentioned Alternative Method of Procurement consistent with Rule XVI and Annex "B" of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184;

**WHEREAS**, the KSU Bids and Awards Committee was tasked to evaluate the Purchase Request No. 2018-01-0011, for the procurement of consulting services;

**WHEREAS**, the services of consultant/s may be engaged by KSU as Procuring Entity for government projects or related activities of such magnitude and/or scope as would require a level of expertise or attention beyond the optimum in-house capability of the procuring entity concerned and consistent with the Government's policy not to compete with the private sector;

**WHEREAS**, consultant/s shall be hired on the basis of their proven expertise, experience and capability, under certain conditions cost may be included as a factor in the selection of consultants;

**WHEREAS**, the following are the grounds for the procurement of said services:

- 1. In case of individual consultants hired to do work that is [ ] highly technical or proprietary; or [ ] primarily confidential or policy determining, where trust and confidence are the primary consideration for the hiring of the consultant;
- 2. That the term of the individual consultants shall, at the most, be on a six-month basis, renewable at the option of the appointing HoPE, but in no case shall exceed the term of the latter.
- 3. That procurement of these services, which involve consulting services for construction of 4 storey Acad Bldg. do not fall under the "Splitting of Government Contracts."
- 4. KSU has ensure that the objectives and purpose of the contract do not constitute an unnecessary, excessive, extravagant, or unconscionable expenditure.
- 5. That the HOPE through the BAC has determined whether KSU is entering into a contract with technically, legally and financially capable consultant(s) by requiring the submission of relevant documents or through other means.

**NOW THEREFORE**, we the Members of the BAC, hereby **RESOLVE AS IT HEREBY RESOLVED**:

to recommend Alternative Method of Procurement through Negotiated Procurement under Highly Technical Consultants as provided in Sec. 53.7, its guidelines, and Annex "B" or General Principles on Consulting Services of the Revised IRR of R.A. 9184 for the above-cited services; and

to recommend the award and approval by the KSU President of this Resolution and Purchase Order to the successful consultant/s as indicated in the Abstract of RFQ/Canvass.

**RESOLVED FINALLY**, to post this Resolution, if applicable, at the PhilGEPS and KSU Websites, and other conspicuous place at the premises of the University including the BAC Bulletin Board.
